

## **Impact of Sports Premium Funding 2014-15**

The impact of the approximate £9500 sport premium funding to support the development of P.E. and school sport in 2014-15 was:

- Purchase of new equipment to deliver new sports and games and boost existing traditional sports taught enabling greater participation and variety of skills teaching and competitive sport
- Developing the capacity of our class teachers and sports coaches through links with Notley High School. This was achieved through funding a PE teacher to come in once a week over the year to work with different classes and teachers, to improve our delivery of Games.
- Participation in the Ramsey Hub of Schools that allowed children to compete in a variety of competitive sports e.g. cross country, athletics and multi-sports and try their hand at new team sports.
- Funding a Sports Coach for the delivery of high quality PE sessions.
- Funding a Sports Assistant for lunchtime games club, allowing all children to participate in active lunchtimes playing a wide variety of games and learning a range of skills.
- Participation in a range of competitive leagues and events in which we were highly successful: -
